I travelled much of Australia and South East Asia, working as a scuba instructor for 8 years in some of the worlds most biodiverse marine ecosystems. From the Great Barrier Reef on the East, the Ningaloo Reef on the West, the tiny critters in the Lembeh Strait and the gigantic sharks in the Sea of the Hebrides. Each one of these places has inspired me and shaped me as an artist, and I couldn't think of a better place to explore the ocean with you than the magical Maldives!






DAY 8

Cruising Speed: 10 – 12 knots

Accommodation: 11 cabins with en-suite bathrooms (1 suite cabin, 6 cabins with twin and queen beds, 2 single cabins, 2 cabins with twin beds, air conditioning with individual controls)

Crew: 10 including captain and chef

Equipment: 20-foot dinghy with 60Hp outboard motor, soundproof marine generators 220V 50 Hz (48 kW ea.); 18,000 litters per day water desalination plant and 8,000 litters freshwater tank, 9,500 litter diesel storage, snorkelling and fishing equipment, fish finder and TV AND DVD

Navigation and communications: satellite and mobile phone, GPS and depth finder, search light.


